Rookie Michael Bristow is still smiling after the second day of the three-day race weekend at the Southern 200 at Timaru Motor Park Raceway. After qualifying twelfth he finished eleventh in race one of the BNT V8s.

Bristow managed to get as high as tenth before he had contact with Nick Ross and then spinning a couple of laps later of his own accord. “We had just a little too much rear brake on and then a bit late on the brakes into turn five. I pinched the rear wheels and around it went. I was a bit lucky in that it was a 360 and I managed to keep going only losing one spot.”

The Tex OnSite team is on track to accomplish their goal of finishing in the top ten for the weekend, an improvement on the last round at Ruapuna late last year where they finished a disappointing seventeenth.

Kayne Scott won the race from Angus Fogg and John McIntyre. Race two and three are tomorrow (Sunday) with the later being a full reverse grid.
